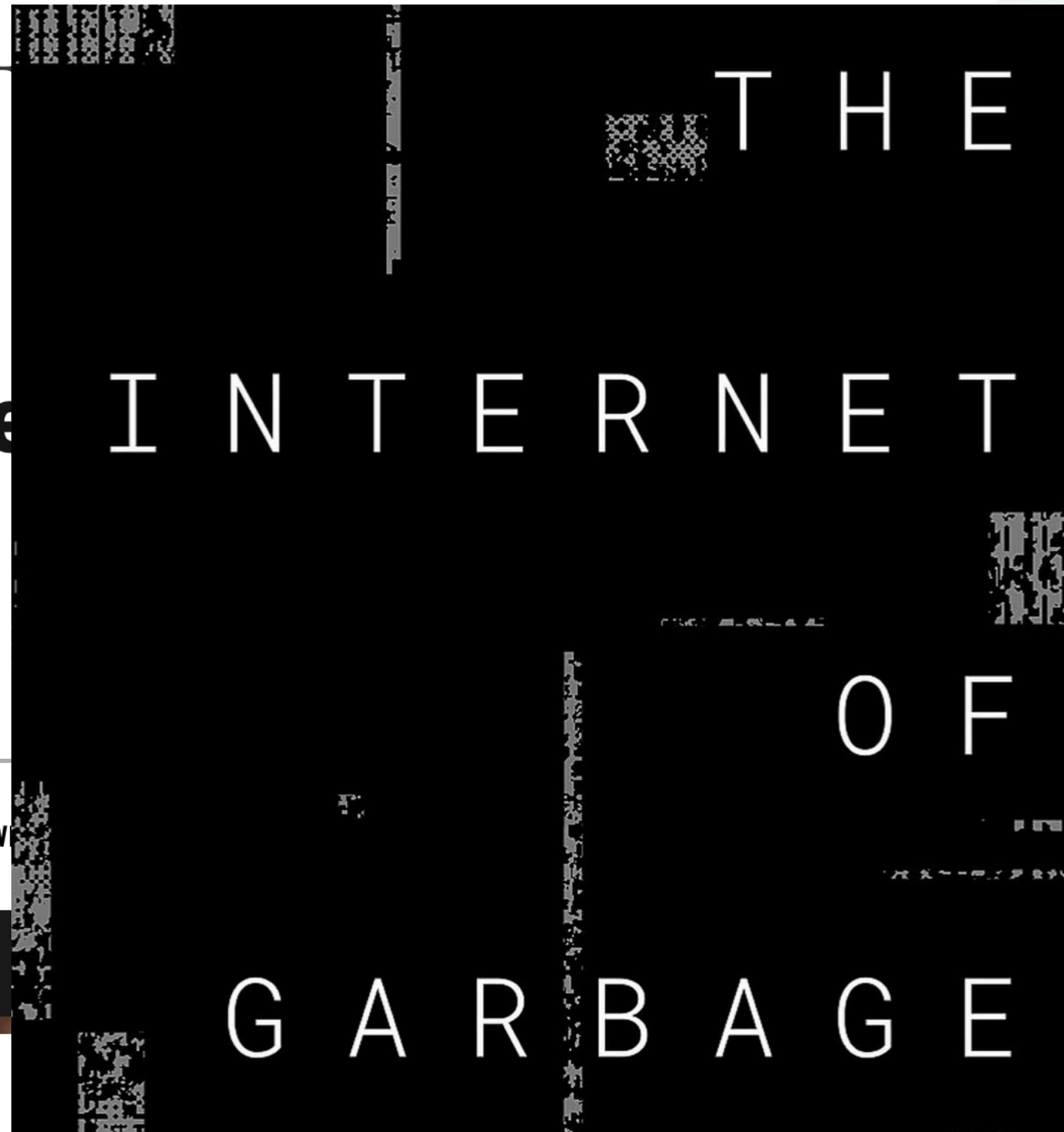
Clean up the Internet
